Observation drawing & design

Get 'cross-curricular' with your Greek topic planning and book an exciting art session that draws inspiration from Greek artefacts!

Pupils handle replica shields, plumed helmets and pot fragments and use images of vases, sculpture and classical figures as inspiration for their own artwork.



Children will become Greek master craftspeople and design shields, helmets or pots using traditional Greek colours of black, gold, white and terracotta, to produce a stunning piece of artwork involving nine designs on a grid.





materials used:

- Pencil, biro, metallic pen, pastel
- Paints and gold inks (2 hour session only)

techniques:

Mark making, drawing, light, shade, tone, proportion, symmetry
