Observation and design

Explore how portraits can be altered to change their meaning and the personality or mood of the character portrayed.



Pupils are provided with nine “outline” drawings, based on one of several portraits in the Artworks Collection, then given the opportunity to be inspired by Warhol, experiment with different colours and change the clothes and background to create a different narrative.

A great opportunity to experiment and stimulate their imagination.





materials used:

- Pencil, felt pen, collage
- Ink, watercolour, poster paint (2 hour session only)

techniques:

Light, shade, tone, composition, colour, pattern

suitable for:

KS2/KS3/KS4
