Appreciation and technique

Learn about 6 pieces of art from our amazing Artworks Collection – we have landscapes, war art, portraits, abstract art, pop art, sculpture, prints, photography and drawings by both significant and less well-known artists.

Pupils observe and discuss the Artworks up close, learning about techniques used. Older pupils can discuss their historical and cultural context.

Activities involve recreating the Artwork in the same style using similar materials, and exploring the techniques used by different artists.



This session is suitable for all key stages as different Artworks can be selected to suit the class. Art can focus on a particular theme, i.e. portraits, or it can utilise a variety of different Artworks from the collection.



Materials used:

- Pencil, soft / hard pastels, oil pastel, charcoal, felt tip
- Watercolours and acrylic paints (2 hour session only)

Techniques:

A variety depending on Artwork used
