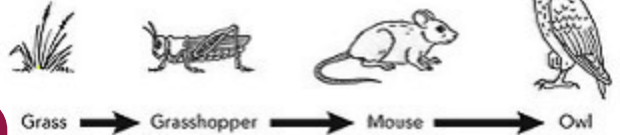


# wild things

## Schools outreach session for Key Stage 2

Children will use a selection of museum animal skulls, skeletons and taxidermy to investigate adaptation, dentition, predator/prey relationships, and food chains.

Children will also discover 'what the owl has eaten?' through owl pellet dissection and careful identification and classification of the bones within the pellet.
