Schools Outreach Session  
for KS2

- Find out about Anglo-Saxon religion and beliefs by looking at local finds and burial sites. Interpret and gather the evidence to learn how these beliefs changed over time.
- Take part in an Anglo-Saxon Autopsy! Early Anglo-Saxon settlers buried their dead with objects. What did they bury and why?
- Look inside Anglo-Saxon Cinerary pots for grave goods. Work out whose remains would have been in the pot from the grave goods found in there.
- Play the ancient game of 9 Men's Morris.
