Printing technique and design

This is what it says on the tin, a fun and addictive printing workshop that allows pupils to experiment in printing using different techniques including mono printing with Perspex and block printing with hand carved wood blocks. Works can be printed onto card, greeting cards, paper bags and gift tags.



The session can be adapted to cover themes such as the natural world, Land & Sea, The Great Fire of London, Bonfire Night, Magical Coral, Day of the Dead and Traditional Indian woodblock patterns.

A very inclusive activity that enables all participants to achieve great results.





**materials used:**

Acrylic paints – this is a messy session and schools should provide aprons for pupils and have sinks nearby

**techniques:**

Printing, experimenting, colour, pattern. Available as 1 or 2 hour session
