Is Graffiti art or vandalism?

Get creative with our funky Graffiti workshop. This session introduces pupils to street art and the skills to write Graffiti style. Using examples of work by Banksy and Jean-Michael Basquiat this session combines time lapse video and live demonstration to get pupils started with the basics then progress onto selecting words and creating their own "tag" design.



STYLE

The session starts with a pre-drawn Graffiti outline, then using step by step video with pauses, pupils colour in the letters using paint pens then decorate them with snazzy patterns, high-lights and shadows using skills and marks typically used by Graffiti artists.





materials used:

- Paint pens, pencil
- Available as a 1 or 2 hour session

techniques:

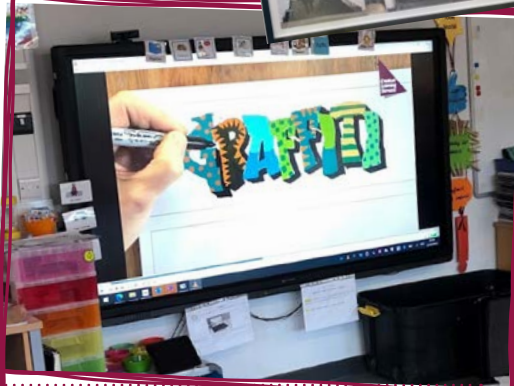
Mark making, drawing, light, shade, tone, symmetry, proportion.
