Discover the different styles of Australian Aboriginal art: from early cave art featuring “x-ray” animals painted on cave walls in Arnhem Land, and the ceremonial art of Aboriginal people living in the Central Australian deserts, to the work of contemporary Aboriginal artists.

Pupils will produce an artwork featuring Australian wildlife including kangaroos, turtles, crocodiles and lizards.

- Pencil, felt pen, conté, pastel
- Paints (2 hour session only)

Mark making, drawing, patterns
