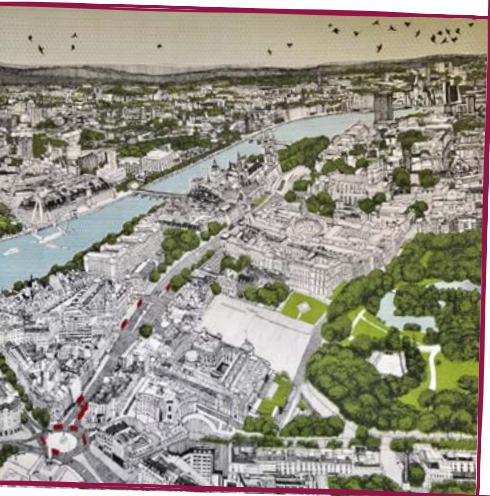


cityscapes!

Drawing inspiration from
London's famous architecture...



The Shard, the Walkie Talkie, the Cheese Grater, the Mummy and The Gherkin are some of the nick names we have for famous London buildings. One thing they all have in common is they're very tall!

This session looks at art from our Artworks collection featuring Cityscapes and the shape and design of different London buildings.

Pupils create a background landscape in ink and are then given a series of fast-paced drawing activities to design their own skyscrapers following a specific set of instructions e.g. drawing with their eyes closed. The results are always surprising. The session is designed to increase drawing confidence and have fun while doing it.

The buildings are then added to the ink landscape then the drawing is refined and collage detail added.



Materials used:

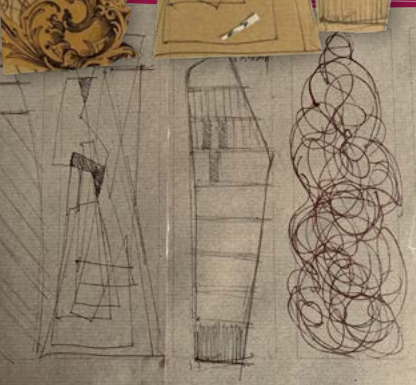
Inks or pastel for background, different pens and pencils for drawing activities. This is a two hour session but a 1 hour session version is available which involves just the drawing activity.

Techniques:

Working with ink, experimenting with ink effects, using different brushes. Speed drawing and collage.
